

## Maryland Dental Radiation Technologist Requirements This information is well-desired to 2005

This information is valid as of Jan. 1, 2023.

The Maryland State Board of Dental Examiners (MSBDE) regulates the duties of dental assistants in the state of Maryland. Under its regulations, the MSBDE provides for dental assistants to operate dental x-ray equipment and perform dental radiographic procedures. The MSBDE requires passing the Dental Assisting National Board, Inc. (DANB) Radiation Health and Safety (RHS®) exam to earn the state's certificate in dental radiologic technology.

To legally operate dental x-ray equipment and perform dental radiographic procedures in Maryland, a dental assistant must be hold a state certificate as a Dental Radiation Technologist.

To obtain this state certificate, one must complete all of the following requirements:

- 1. Be at least 18 years of age
- 2. Be of good moral character
- 3. Hold a high school diploma or its equivalent
- 4. Successfully complete a dental radiography course (minimum of 24 hours) approved by the MSBDE (see p. 2)
- 5. Pass the DANB RHS or Certified Dental Assistant (CDA) exam
- 6. Apply for state certification from the MSBDE after completing all of the above requirements.

Note: On-the-job training does not qualify a dental assistant to operate dental x-ray equipment and perform dental radiographic procedures in Maryland.
